# 1.1 Sustainability

#### Equity among generations:

- "Development that meets present needs without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs" (Quinn, 2000)
- Sustainable development is a "process to reach steady state where both humanity and nature thrive" (Garvate & Isaksson, 2001)
- In many other definitions, the driving forces are equity among generations and virtue.

# 1.2 Sustainability

Issue at stake is the *means* rather than the *goal*:

How to teach and learn the means to sustain life on this planet?

# 1.3 Learning sustainability

Learn how to feel rich by wanting little rather than consuming more;

Kinds of Learning:

Draw legislations in line with natural capacities rather than human desires;

Increase knowledge on how ecological systems respond to human activities.






Vision


